Conference Venue

The conference takes place at *The John McIntyre Conference Centre* (JMCC) and at *South Hall Complex* (SHC) at the Pollock Halls, Edinburgh, from 2-5 June. The Conference Office and Press Rooms will be based at the JMCC (see maps).

Travel

Edinburgh 2010 volunteers will be at Edinburgh airport on Tuesday 1 and Wednesday 2 June to greet delegates and media representatives. Look out for welcomers wearing tartan sashes and carrying an Edinburgh 2010 sign. They will direct you to a coach for travel to Pollock Halls. Parking at Pollock Halls is limited and is on a first come first served basis.



Press Registration

Residential journalists report to Pollock Halls Reception Centre to register for their room and collect keys. Non-residential journalists report to the Conference Office in the JMCC to register for the conference, collect their press passes and conference bags.

Press registration is open on 2 June, 14:15 to 21:30, and from 3-5 June, 8:30 to 21:30.

Catering

Coffee, tea and refreshments will be provided throughout the day.

For journalists having booked a fixed residential/non-residential rate through Edinburgh University, all meals will be available in the JMCC restaurant. Menus cater for a variety of dietary options. See conference programme for times of breakfast, lunch and dinner.

If you have not booked a fixed rate through Edinburgh University, lunch and dinner vouchers may be purchased from the Pollock Halls Reception Centre.

There is a cash point, basic shop, coffee area and bar within the JMCC.

Press Facilities at the Pollock Halls (2-5 June)

The Pollock Halls Press Rooms (Prestonfield and Duddingston) are located at the JMCC, and open on Wednesday, 2 June, 16:00 to 21:30, and 3-5 June, 8:30-21:30.

Wi-Fi access in the JMCC and SHC are free. You will receive a voucher at registration. Wi-Fi access in the bedrooms may be purchased from the Pollock Halls Reception Centre.

Journalists need to bring their own computer. Power sockets are in the press rooms. For any essential printing contact the Conference Office.



Press Facilities at the General Assembly Hall (6 June)

The General Assembly Hall Press Room (Lecture Room 1) is located at New College (enter through General Assembly Hall), and opens on Sunday, 6 June, 14:00-19:00. You will be greeted by stewards wearing tartan sashes.

Journalists need to bring their own computer. Power sockets will be provided. Wi-Fi access in Lecture Room 1 is free. More information on the Sunday Celebrations will be provided at registration.

Press Access to Conference Sessions

Due to limited places in the main hall, the Pentland Suite (PS), all Plenary Sessions will be transmitted to the Press Rooms. Press won't have direct access to the Pentland Suite during the following times:

- 3 June, 11:00, Opening Plenary 'Mission in long perspective'
- 4 June, 11:00, Plenary 2, 'Mission worldwide'
- 5 June, 20:00, Closing Plenary, 'Towards a common call'

Access to sessions of track 1 (study themes 1, 8, 9) may be subject to availability. Access to all other conference sessions is unlimited.

There will be a reception for conference delegates at the Scottish Parliament on the evening of Thursday 3 June. The number of places is strictly limited.
